ABOUT TRINITY CATHEDRAL

Trinity Cathedral is a vibrant faith-infused community with three related, but distinct, ministerial roles. First, we are the Cathedral Church of the Diocese of New Jersey. In this role, we provide hospitality and regular opportunities for worship, learning, and fellowship for all members of the Anglican Communion in the Diocese. Second, we are a parish church; serving members of a diverse worshipping community seeking spiritual development and doing good works, while being faithful stewards of the resources God has granted us. Third, we are a resource to the community. We promote a range of outreach ministries, including the Trinity Cathedral Academy Pre-School, a twice-monthly Food Pantry, a satellite site for the Trenton Area Soup Kitchen, Interfaith Caregivers, and the Cathedral Arts Series at Trinity (CAST).

FRIENDS OF TRINITY CATHEDRAL

Each year, Trinity Cathedral hosts more than 150 diocesan and community events including diocesan worship services, training, concerts, and community meetings. Its members maintain an active outreach ministry including a food pantry serving more than 4,000 clients annually, a concert series offering high quality performances, and an active and expanding youth program. The Cathedral parish is also charged with maintaining a massive and architecturally diverse 40,000-square-foot facility housing four distinct former or current worship spaces and an education wing, more than 2,500 square feet of stained glass, and more than 100 works of religious art and sculpture.

The Friends of Trinity Cathedral are people, parishes, and organizations from throughout the Diocese of New Jersey and from the community-at-large interested in preserving Trinity Cathedral's ministry, architecture, and artistic contributions in the city of Trenton.

ABOUT THE OUTING

In 2004, members of Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, Trenton, New Jersey, organized a golf outing designed to both raise funds for the Cathedral's ministry and foster fellowship among member churches of the Diocese of New Jersey. Since its founding, the outing has raised more than \$500,000 and brings together representatives from more than 20 congregations from the far reaches of the Diocese.



Bishop George E. Cuncell, 11th bishop of the Diocese (2003-2013) was an early and stalwart supporter of what would become a signature event. A genial presence, his infectious enthusiasm greeted participants as they returned to the clubhouse anxious to learn who would be awarded the coveted Bishop's Cup. Following his untimely death in 2018, the outing was named in Bishop Cuncell's honor.

The ministries of Trinity Episcopal Cathedral continue to be inspired by the grace and dignity of Bishop Cuncell, tirelessly serving churchgoers and the greater community at large during these tumultuous times.
