

Each year, Trinity Cathedral hosts more than 150 diocesan and community events including diocesan worship services, training, concerts, and community meetings. Its members maintain an active outreach ministry including a food pantry serving more than 4,000 clients annually, a concert series offering high quality performances, and an active and expanding youth program. The Cathedral parish is also charged with maintaining a massive and architecturally diverse 40,000-square-foot facility housing four distinct former or current worship spaces and an education wing, more than 2,500 square feet of stained glass, and more than 100 works of religious art and sculpture.

In 2004, members of Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, Trenton, New Jersey, organized a golf outing designed to both raise funds for the Cathedral's ministry and foster fellowship among member churches of the Diocese of New Jersey. Bishop George E. Councill, 11th bishop of the Diocese (2003-2013) was an early and stalwart supporter of what would become a signature event. A genial presence, his infectious enthusiasm greeted participants as they returned to the clubhouse anxious to learn who would be awarded the coveted Bishop's Cup. Following his untimely death in 2018, the outing was named in Bishop Councill's honor.

The ministries of Trinity Episcopal Cathedral continue to be inspired by the grace and dignity of Bishop Councill, tirelessly serving churchgoers and the greater community at large during these tumultuous times.
