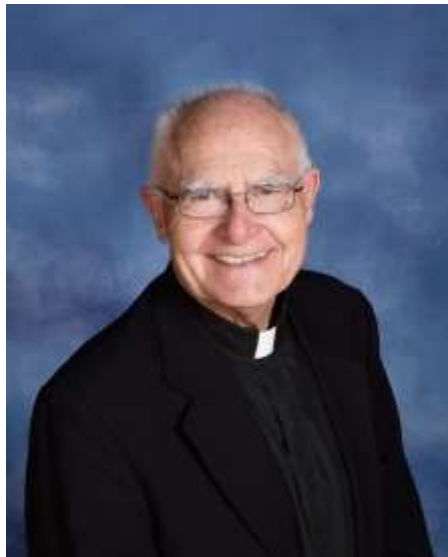

Hundreds of years ago Blaise Pascal said: “All of humanity’s problems stem from man’s inability to sit quietly in a room alone.” I am old enough to remember when people enjoyed sitting on their porches, not doing much of anything, just being there, seemingly at peace. A common and calming sight in Africa is to see a person sitting quietly under the shade of a tree. No book or magazine, no

electronic device. It would be a great mistake to dismiss this as mindless gazing into space, a waste of time. True wisdom comes out of sitting quietly, embracing the sacred stillness. As much or more wisdom comes from that stillness as we are currently getting out of our frenetic noisy jumping-from-one-thing-to-another way of life. Let God visit you on your porch sometimes. Here are a few of my favorite “porch wisdom” prompts:

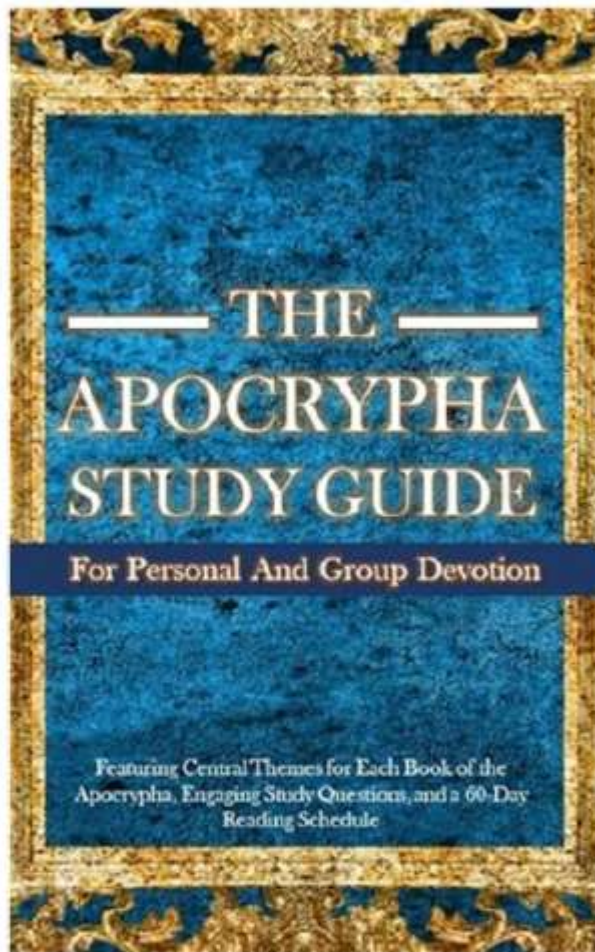

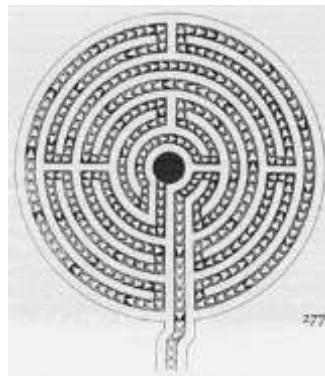

New Trinity Strings Beginning Group Class

Starting in September 2025



Trinity Strings is having open enrollment for their Group String Class! This class offers children aged 4-6 the opportunity to learn to play the violin, viola, or cello in a group setting. During class your child will learn basic technique, theory and note-reading, as well as ensemble skills while playing many fun pieces with their peers. A parent or caregiver is required to attend class and practice at home with the student for the first 2 years. This learning model allows for the most successful start for your child.

Every winter and spring the Group Class performs with [Stretto Youth Chamber Orchestra](http://www.strettoyouthchamberorchestra.org) (www.strettoyouthchamberorchestra.org).

Classes consist of two semesters per year from September – December and January – June for 3 years. After completing the first 3 years, students graduate into private lessons and Stretto Youth Chamber Orchestra.

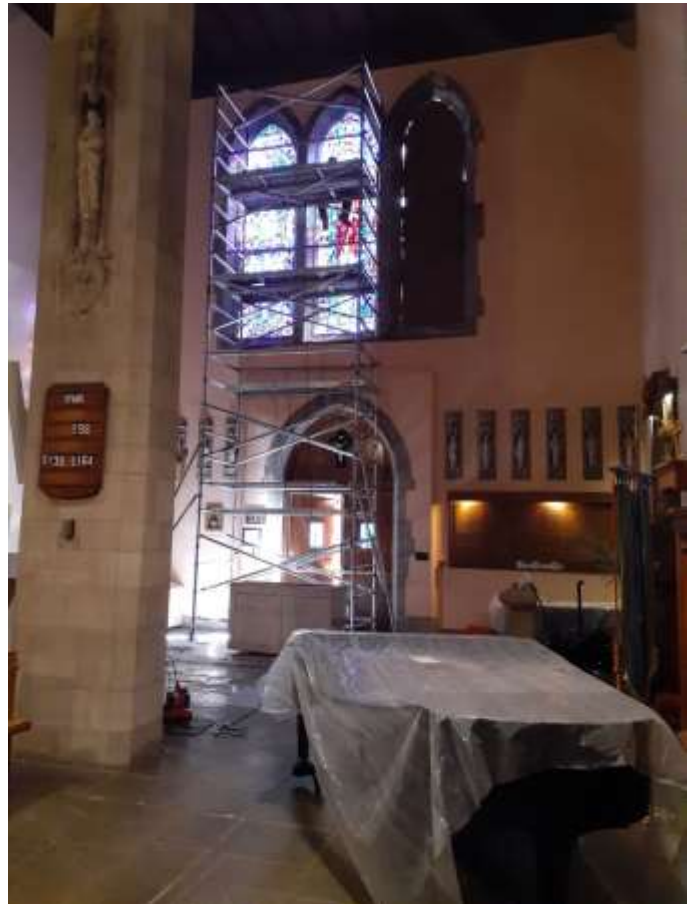

Update on the Stained Glass Restoration Project

Good News! We are anticipating the return of our beautifully restored windows in October! Be on the look out for information as to the exact date. Please consider making a gift towards the payment for this important work. As we reported to you in the last issue of the *Trinity Times* we had a goal of \$17,500 to complete the payment for this work.

To date we have pledges of \$6,500 dollars and still need to raise \$11,000 to fully pay for this work without invading the existing endowment funds. These existing funds produce income on which we depend for the ongoing operational areas of the Cathedral. Any reduction to these existing funds reduces the income they earn, which negatively impacts our budget. Please consider making a commitment to complete the payment of this debt and to the on-going future of the Cathedral that we all love.

The Season of Creation is an ecumenical celebration for Christians, observed annually from September 1st to October 4th, to reflect on and care for God's creation. This month-long period includes the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation on September 1st and concludes on the Feast Day of St. Francis of Assisi on October 4th. During this time, we are invited to pray, take action, and deepen our understanding of our role as stewards of the environment, recognizing interconnectedness and addressing threats like climate change.

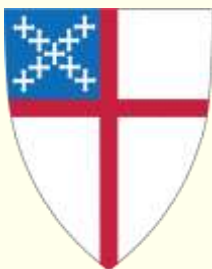
